## **ORDER:**

The Government of Tamil Nadu launched a new scheme "Innuyir Kappom – Nammai Kaakkum 48" on 18.11.2021 and accordingly orders were issued in the Government Order first read above regarding to reduce the death rates due to road traffic accidents. Under this scheme, 81 designated treatment modalities / procedures for damage control measures costing upto Rs.1.00 lakh per individual will be extended on a cashless basis on assurance mode to all victims in the selected 640 IK 48 empanelled Government / Private Hospitals irrespective of whether they possess a Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme (CMCHIS) card or not.

2. Subsequently, the Government have issued in G.O.(Rt)No.381, Health and Family Welfare (EAPI-1) Department, dated:27.03.2023 regarding to implement the "Innuyir Kappom – Nammai Kaakkum 48" scheme under assurance mode for the policy period 16.12.2022 to 10.01.2024.

3. Now, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project in his letter dated 22.03.2024 has furnished the performance of NAMMAI KAKKUM 48 (NK48) Scheme and that scheme will run alongside with Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme with the same insurer under assurance mode. He has further stated that as on 10.01.2024, total number of Pre auth submitted is 71,909 amounting to Rs.60,37,69,444/- and the total of 2,09,561 patients availed treatment under the scheme for an amount of Rs.182.55 crores.

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Program has stated that the State Empowered Committee has approved the proposal and requested to implement this scheme under assurance mode for the next policy period (11.01.2024 to 10.01.2025).

5. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to extend one more year and accordingly issue the orders to implement the "Innuyir Kappom – Nammai Kaakkum-48" scheme under assurance mode for the next policy period (11.01.2024 to 10.01.2025).
