From the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project, letter No.1926/TNHSP/Ins/2022, dated 23.11.2022.

ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has stated that many requests received from Old Age Home/Shelters run by organizations and the Dean, Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai for exemption of mandatory Ration card and Income Certificate to cover the inmates of Old Age Homes and Transgenders under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme. In this regard, a list of inmates in Government recognized Mental Health organizations, Old age Homes and a list of registered Transgenders had been received from the Director of Social Welfare and the same was forwarded to TNeGA for mapping with Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme database and the subsequent report received from the TNeGA is furnished as follows:-

It is mandatory to submit the ration card and income Certificate so as to cover the poor and needy people under the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme. But some category of peoples, there is difficulty in getting Ration card for the single member who doesn't have family or they residing in Homes and also difficulty in getting Income certificate for this category of members. Considering these difficulty, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has requested the Government to waive of Ration card and Income certificate to enroll the 3233 Old Age Home inmates and 4276 Trangenders mentioned above. In this

scenario Aadhaar Card is the only document is mandated to avoid duplication of enrolment. Subsequently the transgender who have registered under the Social Welfare Department apart from the above 4276 members may be allowed to enroll under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme without Ration Card and Income Certificate will be helpful to cover Transgenders to get treatment without any difficulty. Subsequent list authorized by the Social Welfare and Women Empowerment Department is also taken to enroll in future.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has further stated that there is no additional expenditure to the Government except for premium amount of Rs.63,75,141/- as recurring cost and Card cost of Rs.75,090/- as non-recurring cost. For the financial part, she has furnished the breakup details as follows:-

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project has requested the Government to issue orders to waive off Ration Card and Income Certificate to cover the poor and needy eligible Old Age Home Inmates and Trangenders as Aadhaar is mandated.

After careful consideration on the request of the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project, the Government have decided to waive off Ration Card and Income Certificate for those beneficiaries in Government recognised Old Age Homes and Trangenders duly authorised by the Social Welfare and Women Empowerment Department to cover the poor and needy eligible Old Age Home Inmates and Trangenders as Aadhar is mandated under Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of the Social Welfare and Women Empowerment Department vide its U.O.Note No.3673127/SW6(1)/2022-1 dated 10.02.2023 and Finance Department vide its U.O.No.6371/Health-II/2023 Dated: 03.04.2023.
